Back in the fall of 1999 Keene and his team insulated my home in Romeo, MI. Since then I have requested degree-day studies from my local gas company each year. In the 99/00 heating season I realized a 26% reduction in consumption over the prior year. There was no meaningful difference in heating demand, i.e. <1% difference in degree-days, between the two seasons. In the 00/01 heating season, I observed a 14% increase in consumption against a 12% increase in degree-days...virtually flat.
